The court disagreed with this and said to keep it open to all companies not just NFC. Commissioner Deans made the motion for open enrollment to all companies offering all policies to McCulloch County employees with Commissioner Quinn seconded. All in favor motion carries. 5-0
- Order for the Amendment Election was presented and approved by the court with Commissioner Deans making the motion and Commissioner Kemp seconded. All if favor motion carried. 5-0
