



Notice of Public Hearing

The McCulloch County Commissioner's Court will hold a Public hearing for the 2026-2027 Proposed Budget at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, August 31, 2026 in the Commissioner's Courtroom on the first floor of the McCulloch County Courthouse. This budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$34,686.94 (0.0491%) and of that amount \$113,624.65 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year.
