BILLS:

Bills for January 26, 2026, were presented and approved with Commissioner Young making the motion and Commissioner Maricle seconded. All in favor Motion carried. 5-0

Elected Officials/Department Heads: Commissioner Anderson reported that work at the Tax Assessor-Collector’s office related to the Department of Motor Vehicles technology upgrades has been completed.

Commissioner Deans reported that the carpeting at the Justice of the Peace offices needs to be cleaned as soon as possible.

Commissioner Markle reported that millings have been placed to complete work on County Roads 476 and 454.

Commissioner Young reported that he is currently working on County Road 356. He also informed the court that he attended a FOSS meeting regarding the proposed 765 kV transmission line. During the meeting, it was discussed that one larger transmission line would be preferable to several smaller lines running through the area.

County Judge Frank Trull discussed the warming shelter that was established during the recent ice storm. He expressed appreciation to Redeemer Church, The Salvation Army, and the City of Brady for sponsoring the shelter. Judge Trull also reported that the shelter was relocated to the Resource Center due to frozen pipes and related issues. He stated that the court may wish to place this item on a future agenda to discuss long-term planning and options for similar situations.

Discussion: 1. A report on training and statistics was given by Veteran Service Officer Nancy Munetake.


Action:

1. The Court acted and approved to submit an Antiquities Permit Application to the Texas Historical Commission for Brady Revive to add benches to the Courthouse lawn sidewalk area. Commissioner Deans made the motion to approve the submission of the application with Commissioner Maricle seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0.
2. The Court acted and approved a presentation from Delivering Results and Solutions (DRS) -FEMA public assistance consulting introduction and approve a Letter of Engagement for Professional Services. There are two phases in administration and this letter is phase one. Commissioner Young made the motion to approve the Letter of Engagement with Commissioner Anderson seconded. Motion carries. 5-0.
3. The Court discussed, acted and approved a request from the City of Brady for the County to complete and submit an application to the Texas Rural Ambulance Service Grant Program managed by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts. This program provides financial assistance to rural counties to purchase ambulances and necessary modifications. Only County Judges can apply for this Grant. Commissioner Young made the motion with Commissioner Deans seconded. County Judge Frank Trull and Commissioner Anderson voted against. Motion carries 3-2
4. The Court acted and approved a Grant Agreement and Authorized Representative Resolution between the Texas Water Development Board and McCulloch County in an amount not to exceed \$1.2 million dollars to provide for the cost of installation of an outdoor waring siren system. Judge Trull made the motion with Commissioner Maricle seconded. Not carried. There was a Motion to reconsider due to first motion not naming a representative for the County. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Maricle seconded. All in favor Motion carries 5-0. After further discussion Commissioner Deans was named as the

Authorized Representative for the County. The motion was made by Judge Trull with Commissioner Maricle seconded. All in favor Motion carries 5-0.

5. The Court acted and approved on accepting a donation from Brady Creek H.O.A. for proposed road repairs to CR 130 as completed by Cahill Construction, Inc. The donated expense for 5,808 feet of road repair on CR 130 totals \$104,861.00. Commissioner Anderson made the motion with Commissioner Maricle seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0
6. The Court acted and approved on a rental agreement with Warren Cat San Angelo, Texas for CAT CS56B Vibratory Roller to be used on FEMA 4879TX projects. Commissioner Maricle made the motion with Commissioner Young seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0


Having no further business, the meeting adjourned at 11:11 AM with Commissioner Deans making the motion and seconded by Commissioner Young. All in favor motion carried. 5-0
