The Commissioner's Court of McCulloch County met in Regular Session on the 27<sup>TH</sup> day of October 2025 at 9:00 a.m. with the following present:

**BILLS:**

Bills for October 27, 2025, were presented and approved with the stipulation that the repairs for the Boom Axe fan belt be split between all precincts. Commissioner Deans made the motion and Commissioner Young seconded. All in favor Motion carried. 5-0

**Elected Officials/Department Heads:** Commissioner Young reported that he and Commissioner Deans attended training in Abilene and Commissioner Deans noted that the Courthouse Security portion of the training was very helpful.

Commissioner Anderson provided updates on the AgriLife building ceiling, and reported continuous progress on debris removal.

County Judge Frank Trull informed the court that an individual had inquired about purchasing the old Super S Building. They would like the Commissioners Court to make a decision on whether or not they are going to sale the property and for how much. He also stated that with the rains Commissioner Anderson came in and helped him arrange trash cans and buckets in the courthouse that had previously leaked. Judge also reported that Mark Wing with A-Lert Roofing came and assessed the courthouse roof for a tarp. He also asked Allen Odem with Premier Werks whom installed the courthouse roof in 2009 and James Boyd with Boyds of Texas to come and assess the roof for tarps. Judge stated he is hoping to have three quotes to review very soon. Judge Trull further reported attending the Leon Bosque RC&D Council meeting and they have available \$13,852.00 for tire/trash disposal event, \$36,039.00 available to clean up illegal dump sites and \$134,629.00 for Public Water System projects. He informed in any one is interested in finding out more information he will be glad to provide the contact information to them. He also informed the court that McCulloch County received over \$7,000.00 in funding from Leon Bosque RC&D Council this year for tire disposal, trash clean up, and electronics recycling and he feels like other counties and cities that did not receive monies this year, may be first in line for funding. He did state that he did inform board members that if other entities do not apply McCulloch County can always benefit from these types of events. Judge Trull stated it is also that time of the year to apply for grants through the Concho Valley Council of Governments.

**Discussion:**

**Action:**

1. The Court TABLED the discussion of Commissioners court concerns regarding the renewal of a Interlocal Cooperation Contract (ICC) lease for DPS drivers license office occupying 460 square feet of office space at 900 East Main, Brady, TX. 76825 until November 24, 2025. The existing lease contract number 4835 expired on 8/7/2025 but has been extended 90 days while lease terms were modified to adjust for an increase in monthly rent. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Maricle seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0.
2. The Court acted and approved the recognition of the McCulloch County Long Term Recovery Group with a letter of acknowledgment signed by McCulloch County Judge Frank Trull. Commissioner Anderson made the motion with Commissioner Young seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0.

3. The Court acted and approved the presentation by the McCulloch County Child Welfare Board of Tina Keys as a new member to the Child Welfare Board. Commissioner Maricle made the motion with Commissioner Deans seconded. All in favor Motion carried. 5-0
4. The Court discussed acted and approved not to put an Order in place prohibiting outdoor burning. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Young seconded. Motion carries. County Judge Frank Trull and Commissioner Anderson voted for the Order. 3-2
5. The Court acted and approved on the determination that the fuel tanks are salvage for disposal in precinct #1. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Anderson seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0
6. The Court acted and approved with changes on procurement documents for materials for county road and bridge department. Commissioner Young agreed to be the contact person. Notices for bids will need to be sent to newspaper for publication before November 3, 2025. A pre-bid meeting is set for November 21, 2025 at 1:00 PM. Bids will close December 5, 2025 at 5:00 PM and opening of received bids on December 8, 2025 at 9:00 AM. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Anderson seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0
7. The Court acted and approved with changes the procurement documents for hauling of materials for county road and bridge department. Commissioner Anderson made the motion with Commissioner Maricle seconded. All in Favor Motion Carries. 5-0

Having no further business, the meeting adjourned at 12:46 PM with Commissioner Deans making the motion and seconded by Commissioner Young. All in favor motion carried. 5-0
